A strong portfolio should clearly show **your skills, your process, and your results**. Employers want to understand **how you think**, not just what you produced.

1. Portfolio Structure (Template)

★ HOMEPAGE / INTRO

- Your name & title: [Your Name Creative/Technical Title]
- Short tagline: "I create [X] for [Y]."
- Brief intro paragraph (2–3 sentences)
- A clear call-to-action (CTA):
 - o "View my work"
 - "Download CV"
 - o "Get in touch"

ABOUT ME

Template:

I'm a [Your Role] with [X years] of experience in [industry/skills]. I specialize in [technical or creative specialties] and enjoy working on [type of projects]. My work focuses on [your unique style/approach], and I value [professional values: teamwork, innovation, problem-solving].

3. Portfolio Best Practices

√ Show your process

Don't post only the final result—show sketches, drafts, iterations, code versions, etc.

√ Select quality over quantity

5–8 strong projects are better than 20 average ones.

√ Write readable case studies

Employers skim. Use:

- Short paragraphs
- · Section headers
- · Bullet points
- Visuals

√ Make it easy to navigate

Clear menu:

- Home
- Work/Projects
- About



Contact

√ Use consistent branding

Choose:

- 2-3 colors
- 1–2 fonts
- Clean layout

✓ Mobile-friendly layout

Especially important for designers and developers.

√ Keep it updated

Replace older work with newer, better projects every 6–12 months.
